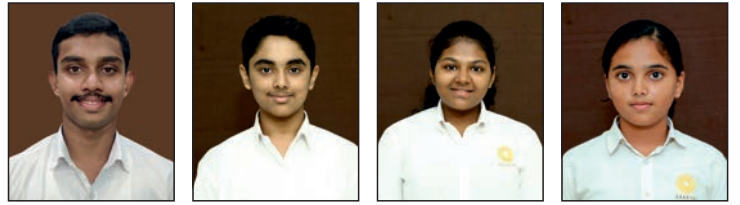

Shining Stars of Shakthi Residential School Excel at State-Level Little Hands Olympiad

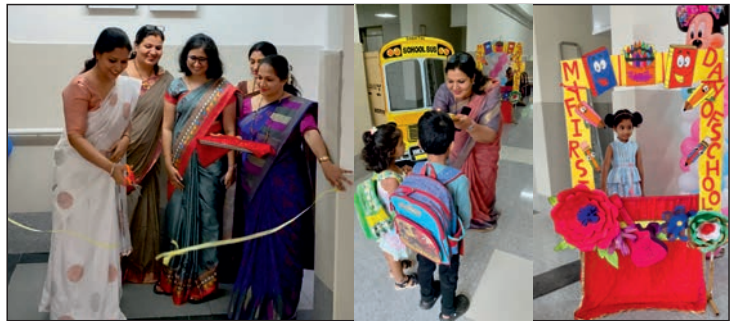

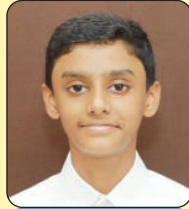
